*Flat land is preferable for camping, stages and moving festival 'gear' and vehicles around the site. However, a gentle slope can help more people to get a better view!*

*Cities contain more people who might be attracted to come to the festival.*

*Festivals are noisy events! It helps if there are not too many people in the immediate area to annoy!*

*Motorways, main roads, rail and even air links help people to get to and from the site more easily.*

*Pleasant, scenic surroundings make the location attractive to people wanting to enjoy the surroundings.*

*Grass recovers and grows back relatively quickly after disturbance. Livestock farms are often extensive and provide large areas for festival crowds.*

*Dry and warm weather is preferable if you're a festival-goer! The south of the UK is warmer and drier, on average, than the north.*
