## ❼ **Imaging Everest Into Nepal and Tibet 1921-1953**

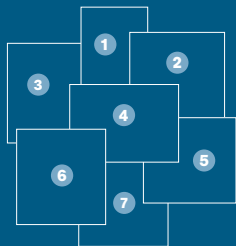
