EXPLORE: the RGS-IBG's annual expedition and field research planning weekend is the largest gathering of its kind. This is a unique opportunity for organisations to showcase their products and services to key individuals involved in all aspects of expeditions, field research and adventure travel and support this exciting aspect of the Society's work.

To complement EXPLORE's extensive programme of talks and workshops, a small number of key organisations are invited to exhibit, and/or advertise in the delegates' notes.

The weekend regular attracts over 250 delegates and over 100 leading field scientists and explorers to the Society's headquarters in London. Explore 2017 delegates will include both professional organisers of expeditions and research programmes, as well as expedition leaders from the university, school, military and adventure communities.

Delegates from previous years have commented on how much they have gained from being able to discuss their needs with exhibitors' expert staff, seeing the products first-hand or even being given a demonstration of how the equipment and/or services can best be applied to their expedition.

Costs for an Exhibitor space is £600 incl. VAT (£500 if booked before 15 October 2017).
