● Overseas Expeditions & Fieldwork: A one-day course for teachers and youth leaders

These one day courses have been designed by the RGS-IBG in association with the LEA Outdoor Education Advisers Panel for any LEA school leader who wishes to plan an overseas expedition or fieldwork.

The Royal Geographical Society with IBG is the world's leading centre for information, training and advice to anyone undertaking scientific or adventurous expeditions overseas. Each year it assists more than 500 teams in planning and preparing their expeditions.

Working with the LEA Outdoor Education Advisors Panel, the Royal Geographical Society with IBG has developed this course for teachers who plan to lead overseas expeditions and fieldwork, possibly using a contracted expeditions company or other Third Party provider. The course is also useful for schools that might want to organise an expedition themselves, or for EVCs supporting their colleagues in this role.

The course is facilitated by a speaker from the RGS-IBG with valuable experience of youth expeditions, in association with an LEA Outdoor Education Advisor.

The course covers the key elements and procedures of planning an expedition: including setting educational objectives for the expedition; where to go for information and advice, establishing competence, leadership and supervision, expedition planning and administration, Risk Assessment, contingency

and emergency procedures, post expedition evaluation and reports.

By attending this course delegates will also earn 5 CPD points which can be put towards the yearly requirement of 35 CPD points to attain Chartered Geographer status. A certificate of attendance will be given for all delegates.
