 - You will have **TWO** shareable links for your session contributors - please make sure you send them the correct link for the timeslot to which you'd like to allocate them.
- Please select the 'Panels (to submit session overview details only)' track.
- If your session is organised as a panel, roundtable, workshop, etc. where contributors will not have separate titles and abstracts for their contributions: please list all contributors as 'Discussants' in the 'Roles' screen.
- If your session is sponsored by a Research Group, please select the relevant group from the list of available topics. Unsponsored sessions should select 'Annual Conference 2026' only.
- Please skip the pages of additional questions for 'Open call for papers authors' and 'Panel (organised session) paper contributors' - leave the answers blank.






